## COUNTRY PROFILE

Sri Lanka continues to experience an unprecedented economic crisis with high inflation, rising commodity prices, power shortages and lack of fuel. The crisis is deepened by a serious reduction in agricultural production caused by a failed agricultural transition. Sri Lanka is blessed with abundant water resources. Those water resources have geographically been classified into surface and ground water. In Sri Lanka, groundwater resources are widely used for domestic, commercial and industrial purposes, small scale irrigation, water supply schemes and other purposes. About 80% of the rural domestic water supply needs are met from groundwater by means of dug wells and tube wells.

## HOW YOU HAVE HELPED

Your donation will make it possible for the beneficiaries to get clean water from underground source. This is especially crucial in areas without centralised water supplies or with inadequate water infrastructure. Water wells will make it possible for people to obtain water for their daily needs, such as drinking, cooking, sanitation, and other necessities, lowering the risk of waterborne illnesses. The beneficiaries will also benefit from a time-saving solution because they previously had to travel far distances to access water that was only moderately clean before this well was installed.
